

## “Resilience Day – What we can learn from crises”

### – International Online Conference & Bar Camp –

After experiencing global crises like the Covid-19 pandemic or the war in Ukraine, Higher Education Institutions are facing new challenges and new aspects have become part of Higher Education Management. In an ever-changing world, where nothing is stable, not only concepts of crisis management and business continuity management have moved into the focus of Higher Education Management, but also resilience has become of crucial importance.

What does resilience mean in the context of Higher Education? What does it imply for the management of Higher Education Institutions? What can we learn from the recent crises?

Questions like these will be tackled during our Resilience Day, which takes place in the framework of FH Münster’s project “THEA Ukraine X” (Multiplication Trainings for Higher Education Administrators in Ukraine). The Resilience Day is organised in cooperation with our project partner Sumy State University and with Leibniz University Hannover, which is carrying out our sister project “Management of Internationalisation” for Ukrainian HE managers.

Considering the current relevance for many Higher Education Institutions, we would like to see lively discussions from different perspectives around the topic of resilience. We therefore invite higher education managers, administrators and others interested in networking and an active exchange about the topic.
